GENERAL RULES

1. All pony classes will be limited to 56" & under. All horse classes will be over 56" (our committee reserves the right to measure any animal)
2. **ALL EXHIBITORS WILL ENTER RING WEARING APPROPRIATE ATTIRE.** Hats are optional in contesting events, but if worn must be western type or protective headgear.
3. Noble County 4-H Horse and Pony Club, through Purdue University Cooperative Extension Office, recommends the use of helmets in all mounted events.
4. Exhibitors must enter ring when called or will be disqualified. Horse may be entered one (1) time per class.
5. **Show committee or ringmaster may excuse any contestant for unsportsmanlike conduct. No animal abuse will be tolerated.**
6. Entries for each class will close when 1st rider of the class enters arena Friday and Saturday Speed Shows. Entries for each class **will close 2 classes prior to class entering during Sunday Pleasure Show.**
7. High point awards to be on 1 horse/1 rider. In case of 1 exhibitor winning both open & youth, only 1 buckle will be awarded to that exhibitor. 2nd buckle winner will be determined by the closest number of points to the winner. In case of a tie, the flip of a coin will decide the winner. **Eight (8) and under and pony classes will not count toward high point. Saturday Classes for contesting and Sunday Pleasure count**
8. Judge's decision will be final.
9. We will not be responsible for accidents or loss of property.
10. A non-refundable fee of \$50 must accompany all protests.
11. **ABSOLUTELY NO REFUNDS ON ENTRY FEES.**
12. *When arena is cleared and name called Rider must break timer within 60 seconds; this will be strictly enforced*

RULES:

1. All competitors must be a 4-H Horse & Pony member in the county they represent and must exhibit their 4-H project.
2. There will be two divisions: one team consisting of horse competitors & one team of pony competitors. Jr. & Sr. exhibitors are combined.
3. Each competitor & animal may exhibit in only one division and one event.
4. Teams may enter with less than eight entries. . Entry fee for each team will be \$80. If you are entering a horse and pony team, you must remit \$160.00. **Entry forms & fees must be postmarked no later than June 26, 2009.** RESPECTIVE COUNTY EXTENSION OFFICE MUST APPROVE ALL ENTRIES.
5. Each county club or organized 4-H Horse & Pony Club may enter only one team per division, one competitor per class.
6. OFFICIAL HANDBOOK OF THE INDIANA 4-H HORSE & PONY PROGRAM will apply in all events.
7. Points earned in each class as follows: 1st place receives 10 points through 1 point for 10th place, regardless of the number of entries in the class. Total team points will declare tournament winners. In case of a tie, team with the highest placing will be declared the winner.
8. A team representative must report to the entry booth by 8:30am to verify entries. No exhibitor changes after that time.
9. All entries must appear in the Grand Entry as a team to be judged for best overall appearance. Showmanship animals may appear in halter.
10. First place teams will receive MID STATES 4-H TEAM TOURNAMENT Jackets. Awards through 5th place teams. Ribbons to first 5 in each event.
11. PROTECTIVE HEAD GEAR IS REQUIRED IN ALL EVENTS AND WHENEVER COMPETITOR IS MOUNTED. NO EXCEPTIONS!! LONG SLEEVED SHIRTS MUST BE WORN AND BUTTONED AT THE CUFFS UPON ENTERING THE ARENA. **Shirts must be tucked in.**
12. All protests must be made within 15 minutes of end of class and accompanied by a \$50 non-refundable fee.
13. Our committee reserves the right to measure any animal. Random measuring will be done.
