Ages as of 1st of year. Jr. 13 and under. Sr. 14 and over.

A qualified Circle K-D person will judge and manage timed events.

Casual attire, horses need not be clipped or bathed. **Boots & negative Coggins required.** Also horses coming over Illinois state line require Health Certificates. Safety helmets are required for all English classes. Helmets are always highly recommended in all classes at K-D. Show committee has final decision on any changes or disputes.

Circle K-D or its members are not responsible for ANY injury or loss of property. **ALL SAFETY RULES WILL BE FOLLOWED!!!** Classes may be cancelled or combined. Riders must register and pay class fees before they are added to a class. No refunds on fees.

*These classes are designed for beginner riders. Novice riders are allowed in Novice, Walk Trot, Horsemanship, Pleasure, Equitation, Trail, Speed 4-H Classes only. If the judge feels a rider is too experienced, they will be asked to leave and may transfer to another class. **ALL RULES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.**

SHOW RULES:

- Classes may be cancelled or combined.
- Circle K-D or its members are not responsible for any accidents, injuries, or loss of property. You ride at your own risk!
- All Circle K-D rules will be enforced and must be followed at all times.
- This show was designed to be fun, reasonably priced and to teach or school either horse or rider for the upcoming show season.
- No Stallions.

Novice Class

- A Novice Rider is defined as an individual who has NOT won 2 first place classes in one calendar year.
- These classes are designed for beginner riders regardless of age, not horses.
- Novice riders are allowed in novice walk trot, novice horsemanship, novice pleasure, Trail, 4-H, and speed classes.
- It is at the Judges discretion if a rider is too experienced for this class. These are the steps that will be taken:
 1. He or she will judge the class and place according to the rider's abilities.
 2. After the results of the class have been turned into the announcer, the judge will ask the rider to transfer to the higher-level classes.
 3. The rider will forfeit any points from the previous class that were being accumulated towards the high point award.

Lead Line:

- Judging will be based on the rider's ability to control and steer the horses themselves.
- The lead person is there for safety in case a horse gets out of control.

Class Fees:

- Please note that class fees are due when you sign up at the booth. A card for each class must be completed and fees paid for each horse and rider combination.
- If you ride all day, a deposit is required in the form of a blank check made out to Circle K-D. At the end of the day your classes are totaled and the check is finalized.
- You or a member of your family may transfer to another class (in advance).
- There are no refunds.
