Other entry fees: \$5 (no added \$\$); \$6 for up to \$25 added; \$8 for \$50 added; \$10 for \$75 added or more

**60% payback for all classes to 4 places except NSBA** (must have 6 in class for payback/added money)

**NSBA classes 55% payback to follow NSBA payback schedule**

**Series High point and reserve high point awards for four age groups** (one rider, one horse)

Highpoint nomination fee: \$3 (must be entered by end of halter classes)

Stall fee: \$25 (no bedding furnished; only shavings to be used in stalls)

**Classes counting for Highpoint Awards:** Showmanship, English pleasure, Western pleasure (in age group)  
Jr. Horse is a horse 5 years or younger; All Class changes must be made at least 3 classes in advance; Ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup> place in all classes; Rider's age is as of January 1, 2010; **No Refunds; Judges decisions are final; Inhumane treatment of horses and unsportsmanlike conduct may result in being barred from further showing**
