**CASH PRIZES\***

- Teams of three will compete in *pole bending, barrel racing, and flag racing*-in that order. Each competitor will compete in each event (for a team total of nine runs).
- Placings will be based on combined times of all three competitors in all three events.
- Open to Indiana, Michigan, and Ohio counties.

*Rules:*

1. *Three participants per team must be enrolled in 4-H and exhibit their 4-H project.*
2. *Blue 4-H enrollment papers must be shown at check in.*
3. *In the event of a disqualification (i.e.-off pattern) 35 seconds will be added to the total team time.*
4. *In the event of a tie, each team will choose one competitor who will run a barrel pattern. Fastest time wins.*
5. *One alternate is allowed per team in the event of illness or injury to participant and/or animal. Alternate can be chosen day of event but cannot be changed after start of show.*
6. *Judges decision is final. Protests must be within 15 minutes of end of contestants run with a \$50 non-refundable fee.*
7. *Entry fee is \$60.00 per team. Entry forms and fees must be postmarked no later than Friday, July 30, 2010.*
8. *Each county may enter as many teams as they wish. However, there will be no cross-entering of horse or rider. One horse/rider combination per team.*
9. *No exhibitor changes after check in.*
10. *Helmets must be worn when mounted. Shirts must be tucked in and have a four-inch sleeve with collar.*
11. *4-H rules will be applied unless stated otherwise.*
12. *No abuse of any kind will be tolerated. Discretion of show committee is final.*
13. ***\*Cash prizes given to top 5 teams. Individual prizes awarded to top time in each event. Minimum cash prizes as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> place-\$360; 2<sup>nd</sup> place-\$300; 3<sup>rd</sup> place-\$240; 4<sup>th</sup> place-\$180; 5<sup>th</sup> place-\$120. With 40 teams (maximum), 1<sup>st</sup> place-\$720; 2<sup>nd</sup> place-\$600; 3<sup>rd</sup> place-\$450; 4<sup>th</sup> place-\$300; 5<sup>th</sup> place-\$240.***
